AC'CENT provides complete tank management including all record management for PSTs such as release detection testing (EPA third-party certified GAS SYSTEM® monthly vapor monitoring, Veeder-Root Distributor for Automatic Tank Gauge Systems, EPA third-party certified SIRmadeSIMPLETM monthly statistical inventory reconciliation - SIR), Line leak detector tests, corrosion rectifier tests and corrosion surveys, corrosion system installation and repair, ASTM 1527 Phase I assessments, pollution and third-party liability insurance and compliance audits. All test methods have EPA third-party approval which is available upon request.

Mr. Brevard is currently on the National Petroleum Equipment Institute Committee which authored the Recommended Practices for the Testing and Verification of Spill, Overfill, Release Detection and Secondary Containment Equipment, PEI/RP1200. This is a national and industry standard used by EPA and all state agencies.

Mr. Brevard is currently on the National Petroleum Equipment Institute Committee which is authoring the Recommended Practices for Closure of Underground Storage Tanks and Shop-Fabricated Aboveground Storage Tanks, PEI/RP1700.
